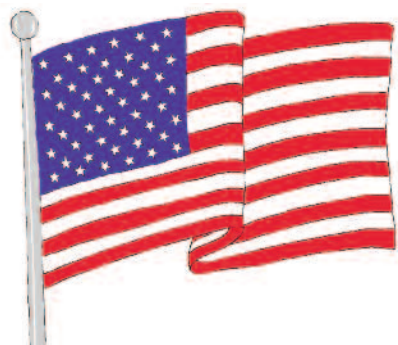

## Savannah, Georgia History

*Three Centuries of History*



**\*Savannah History Museum and Battlefield Memorial Park:** Housed in the former Central of Georgia Railway passenger shed, a National Historic Landmark. The museum details Savannah's role in the Civil War and American Revolution. The site where 8,000+ troops clashed for the control of Savannah in one of the deadliest battles of the American Revolution in 1779.



**\*Georgia State Railroad Museum:** A National Historic Landmark and vibrant part of Savannah's industrial heritage which was used until 1963. Tour the boxcars and see a functioning turntable.



**\*Massie Heritage Center:** Strives to create an appreciation of Savannah's rich cultural heritage by preserving the historic Massie School as an interactive exhibit space and educational facility. Guests can participate in interpretive programs that are designed to stimulate curiosity and to help achieve academic goals. Step back in time and take a seat in an authentic 1900s classroom to experience school as it would have been at the turn of the last century. Do your arithmetic on a slate board, practice your handwriting and read aloud from old schoolbooks.



## Fort Frederica National Monument and the Coastal Georgia Historical Society

St. Simons Island, Georgia



**\*The World War II Home Front Museum** - Following Pearl Harbor, the Golden Isles of Georgia became an important component of the “Arsenal of Democracy” as declared by President Franklin D. Roosevelt. Housed in the historic Coast Guard Station the museum tells the multi-faceted story of the bold initiatives to protect our coast from German submarines, train fighter pilots in the latest technology, build Liberty Ships to supply our troops overseas.



**\*St. Simons Lighthouse Museum and Keepers Dwelling** - Built in 1868-72 replacing an earlier light station destroyed during the American Civil War. The tapering brick tower still serves as an Active Aid to Navigation and houses the original third order Fresnel lens. Designed and manufactured in France, the lens casts its beam 23 miles out to sea. The dwelling was home to lighthouse keepers and their families until the light was automated in the mid-1950's.



**\*Fort Frederica National Monument** - Established in 1736, three years after the founding of Savannah, by James Oglethorpe to protect his southern boundary from Spanish and British conflict. Fort Frederica's troops defeated the Spanish 1742 in the Battle of Bloody Marsh ensuring Georgia's future as a British colony.
